

Stowaway Album Directions:



1. From the cardboard packaging, cut four $4\frac{1}{4}$ " x $6\frac{3}{4}$ " pieces. Glue two together so that white side of cardboard is on the outside. Repeat with other two.

2. Cut two $5\frac{1}{4}$ " x $7\frac{1}{4}$ " pieces of *Deep Blue Dreams* and adhere each of the cardboard units from Step 1 to the center as shown below.

3. Snip the four corners at an angle then fold in and adhere. Repeat with second set.

Approx. 76" Natural twine
 8" x 6" scrap cardstock template (for Stowaway Album)
 7 $\frac{1}{8}$ " x 2" piece of kraft cardstock (for Treasure Chest)

Tools, Adhesives & Ink:

Paper trimmer, scissors, ruler, scoring tools, bone folder, paper piercer, craft knife & craft mat, wet & dry adhesives, foam adhesive, strong glue, packing tape or other strong tape, Scotch-tape for temporary hold, brown ink (optional)


Notes:

- All measurements are width x height, unless specified.
- When cutting papers, be mindful of the pattern direction.
- If desired, distress paper & chipboard edges w/ brown ink.

4. Cut three 12" x 4" pieces of *Aquatic Passage*. Fold one in half and burnish with a bone folder.



5. Rotate the folded paper from Step 4 so the fold is at the top, then fold up one half to the top of the fold and burnish well. (Photo shows two angles to help you.) Now flip it over and do the same with the other half.



6. Rotate the unit so the folds are at the top again and fold up one half and burnish. Flip over and repeat.





7. At this point you'll have the yellow side showing with two half folds and a longer section. Invert this whole thing to the other side of the paper, keeping the half folds folded inward. Refer to photo.




8. Making sure you have the single fold at the top, this time fold up two half folds to the top.

9. Flip it over and fold up the remainder in the same way. Burnish folds well.



10. You should have an accordion folded piece like the photo with the first and the last folds as "mountains."

11. Repeat the same steps (5 - 9) with the second piece. For the third piece, do the same steps starting from the other side of the paper. You will have what is shown in photo.



12. Adhere the units into one long accordion by placing adhesive as indicated by arrows.

13. With the yellow side facing out, adhere all the mountains closed. You should have a total of 12.



14. Cut the following papers 8" x 6" each: (2) *Wild Wild Waves*, (2) *Neptune's Adventure*, (1) *Steampunk Splash*, (1) *Ocean Quest* and (2) *Aquatic Passage*. Fold in half at 4" and open back out.

15. From scrap cardstock, cut a template 8" x 6" and fold in half at 4". Lay the folded accordion hinge along the fold line, centered top to bottom, then pierce a hole just above and just below, as indicated



by the arrows. (These should be $\frac{15}{16}$ " from the top and bottom.) Lay the template over the papers from Step 14 (You can stack 3 or 4 at a time) and pierce the holes through all the layers. Repeat with all 8 pieces.



16. Use a ruler and craft knife to make a slit from one hole down to the other of each of the 8 pieces.


17. Adhere the first single flap of the accordion hinge to the outside front cardboard cover from Step 2, centered top to bottom.



18. Flip open the front cover and adhere the next accordion hinge to the inside as shown.



19. Lay the other cardboard cover face down, lined up with the front cover, with about $\frac{5}{8}$ " spacing between and adhere the second to last accordion hinge to the inside. Close the album and adhere that final hinge down onto the back cover.




20. Slide your pages onto each of the accordion hinges in this order: *Neptune's Adventure* (plaid facing down), *Wild Wild Waves* ("My Soul"...side facing down), *Aquatic Passage*

(yellow side down), *Steampunk Splash* (seaweed down), *Ocean Quest* (words down), *Wild Wild Waves* (mermaid down), *Aquatic Passage* (seahorses down), *Neptune's Adventure* (collage images down).

21. Cut two 4" x 6" pieces of *Steampunk Splash* and adhere to inside front and back covers.

22. From the B-side of *Voyage Beneath the Sea* and *Mermaid Melody*, cut four 6" x 5" pieces and fold in half at 3" with the fold on the right edge of each.

23. Starting with one of the blue shell papers from the previous step, place adhesive on the entire back side and adhere to the first hinge in the album, straddling the hinge so it's hidden inside. Continue through the rest of the album, alternating the orange shell and blue shell papers.



24. From the B-side of *Mermaid Melody*, cut two 3 3/4" x 5 3/4" pieces. From *Voyage Beneath the Sea*, cut the mermaid out by following

the blue border and making sure she is 4 1/4" tall. Locate the three metal clock pieces and the chipboard label.

25. Lay the mermaid cut-apart over one of the orange shell papers, centered, and trim excess off right and left edges. Adhere papers to front and back covers as shown.



26. Close the album and adhere the chipboard label with foam adhesive. Use strong glue to adhere three metal clock pieces. Tie the 10" of twine into a bow through the other chipboard banner and adhere. Let dry.

27. Cut apart the "Voyage" piece from *Wild Wild Waves* (3 5/8" x 2 5/8") and adhere to inside front cover. Cut apart "I Love You More Than




All the Fish in the Sea" at the same measure and set aside. Add another metal clock and follow the photo for stickers and chipboard pieces on right hand page.

28. Continue to embellish the album with stickers and chipboard, following the photos. There is one mermaid fussy cut from *Neptune's Adventure*.

The Stowaway Album is now complete. Next we'll begin the coordinating Treasure Box!



Treasure Chest Directions:



Your treasure box should look like the chest in this photo when complete.

1. Locate the large, scored chipboard piece and fold on all score lines in the same direction. This is the lid of the treasure box. With folded panels curved toward you, lay the unit onto a non-stick surface. Apply thick tacky glue to the top inside edge only of one of the two chipboard pieces shaped like a long-house. Press this piece up against the larger piece in between the two score lines, as shown. Hold until set.




2. Repeat with the other side piece, as shown. Set aside to dry fully.

3. Once dry, apply a bead of thick tacky glue to the inner edges of the side pieces and press to the lid, matching the scored areas with the "house" edges. It's helpful to work on one side at a time and to stand the lid up on its side as you work. (Tip: use a bit of scotch tape as a temporary hold and peel it away later.)



4. Onto the outside edge of the large chipboard base, adhere one long front piece and hold until set. Repeat with the back piece. This will be the main box portion of the treasure box.



5. Adhere the two side pieces to the outside edges remaining. Square everything up nicely, and hold until set. (Again, use scotch tape as a temporary hold.)

6. Place the treasure box lid onto the main box. Join them with clear packing tape or any strong tape along the seam of where they meet in the back.


This will get completely covered with paper later.




7. Cut a 7 $\frac{1}{8}$ " x 2" piece of kraft cardstock and fold in half at 1" to create an inner hinge for the lid, for added strength. Adhere to the inside lid and box as shown.

Note: Edges of decorating papers have been inked with brown ink to achieve the look of separate planks. In this project, it's recommended to take this extra step.



9. From one sheet of *Deep Blue Dreams*, cut the following strips: (2) $7\frac{1}{4}$ " x $1\frac{1}{2}$ ", (1) $7\frac{1}{4}$ " x $1\frac{5}{8}$ ", (5) $7\frac{1}{4}$ " x 1", and (1) $7\frac{1}{4}$ " x $2\frac{3}{8}$ ". (Note: for a neater look, keep your vertical stripes lined up as you adhere them to the box.)



10. From a second sheet of *Deep Blue Dreams*, cut: (6) $5\frac{1}{4}$ " x 1", (2) $5\frac{1}{4}$ " x $2\frac{1}{2}$ ", and (1) $7\frac{1}{4}$ " x $3\frac{1}{8}$ ".




11. Adhere one of the $5\frac{1}{4}$ " x $2\frac{1}{2}$ " pieces to the side of the lid and trim off the top corners. Repeat on other side of lid.

12. Working from the top of the lid down to the front (where the box opens) adhere the $7\frac{1}{4}$ " x $3\frac{1}{8}$ " piece to the top, the $7\frac{1}{4}$ " x $1\frac{1}{2}$ " next, then the $7\frac{1}{4}$ " x $1\frac{3}{8}$ " piece.



13. Flip the box around to the back and, working downward, adhere the second $7\frac{1}{4}$ " x $1\frac{1}{2}$ " piece, then skip past the taped hinge area and adhere two of the $7\frac{1}{4}$ " x 1" strips as shown.




14. Score the $7\frac{1}{4}$ " x $2\frac{3}{8}$ " piece at 1" as indicated by the red line in the photo.

15. Fold on score line. Ink the fold so it has the same feel as the other pieces.




16. Adhere the scored piece to the back over the taped hinge area.

17. Adhere three $5\frac{1}{4}$ " x 1" strips to the side of the base and repeat on other side.



18. Adhere three $7\frac{1}{4}$ " x 1" strips to the front of the base.

19. From *Aquatic Passage* cut four 3" vertical borders and four 3" double borders as shown. (Note: if you are making the mini album project, these cuts can be made from the same sheet as the two album pages.)



20. From another sheet of *Aquatic Passage* cut four 9 1/8" vertical borders, two 3" and six 2 1/2".



21. Fold the four double borders from Step 19 in half.

22. Adhere the four folded pieces to the corners of the box base.



23. Adhere two 9 1/8" borders to the outer edges of the lid. (Note: you will have to trim off a bit from the long edge of each to line up with the corner papers.)

24. Adhere two 2 1/2" borders to the sides of the lid. Repeat on other side.



25. Trim the excess off, then adhere a 2 1/2" border centered, then a 3" border on the base. Repeat on other side.

26. Adhere two 3" borders to the base front, spaced evenly, then adhere the last two 9 1/8" borders to the lid. Flip the box around to the back and adhere the last two 3" borders.



27. Tie twine through two small clock charms and adhere to the large decorative chipboard as shown.

Once dry, adhere this unit to the lid, hanging off halfway. Clamp in place until dry.

28. Onto each side of the lid, adhere the "Wonder" and "Voyage" chipboard pieces with foam adhesive as shown.
