– Steampunk Splash Card Set –

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Graphic 45® Supplies:

- 1 ea Voyage Beneath the Sea 8 x 8 Paper Pack (4502255)
- 1 pk Voyage Beneath the Sea Die-Cut Chipboard (4502256)
- 1 pk Chip Shape 12 pc Sprockets–Natural (ADPSHAPE.1007)
- 1 pk 5½" x 5½" Cards & Envelopes–Kraft (ADP3585-6.119G45)

Additional Supplies, Tools, Adhesives & Ink:

Paper trimmer, detail scissors, ruler, scoring tool, bone folder, various adhesives, foam adhesive, brown distress ink (optional)

Notes:

- Measurements are width x height unless specified.
- Optional: Distress paper edges with ink before adhering.
- The following instructions are for three cards. Use the remaining supplies provided in your kit to create three additional cards by following the steps using other papers!

Directions:



Card #1

1. From the B-side of *Neptune's Adventure* cut a piece to measure 4½" x 4½" and adhere this to the inside of the card. Trim out the starfish journal card from *Wild Wild Waves* and adhere this to the upper portion of the inside of the card.
2. From the B-side of *Neptune's Adventure* cut a piece to measure 5¼" x 5¼" and adhere to the front of the card.
3. From *Voyage Beneath the Sea* trim off the left side of the page containing the three cut-a-parts. The right facing seahorse, octopus, and the voyage beneath the sea element.
4. Trim out the seahorse element. Set the remaining two elements aside for later.
5. Cut another piece from the B-side of *Voyage Beneath the Sea* to measure 4¾" x 4¾" and adhere this to the front of the card, having an even border of the previous paper showing.
6. Trim out the orange shell border strip from the *Deep Blue Dreams* paper to measure 5½". Adhere this to the front approximately 1¼" from the bottom. (See photo for placement)
7. Cut a piece from the B-side of *Aquatic Passage* to measure 2 x 4½" and layer the seahorse element onto this piece. Then add this element to the front of the left side of the card with foam adhesive.
8. Ink two of the sprockets with brown ink. (I used distress ink in vintage photo but you can use any brown ink to add color to the chipboard sprockets.) Adhere the sprockets to the front of the card as shown. Layer the two chipboard elements to the centers of the sprockets.
9. Fussy cut a starfish from *Steampunk Splash* and adhere to the front as shown.
10. Trim a 8" x ¾" piece from the B-side of *Neptune's Adventure* and adhere it to the outside of the envelope along the bottom front edge as shown and trim off the excess. Trim out the octopus that we cut out in step 3 and adhere it onto the front also. (See photo)

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Card #2

1. From the B-side of *Aquatic Passage* cut a piece to measure 4½” x 4½” and adhere it to the inside of the card. Trim out “The sea is calling” journal card from *Wild Wild Waves* and adhere it to the inside as shown.
2. From the B-side of *Ocean Quest* cut a piece to measure 5¼” x 5¼” and adhere it to the front of the card. Trim another piece from the B-side of *Aquatic Passage* to measure 5¼” x 2” and adhere it to the center of the card front. (See photo)
3. Trim out the man riding the fish from *Mermaid Melody* and adhere to the center front of the card with foam adhesive.
4. Ink two more sprockets and layer them together and adhere to the bottom left corner of the card overlapping the focal image as shown. (Add some foam adhesive to the bottom left of the sprockets for support)
5. Layer the chipboard elements and adhere as shown in the photo.

6. From the B-side of *Ocean Quest* cut a piece to measure 8” x ¾” and adhere it to the bottom front of the envelope and trim off the excess. Trim out the *Voyage Beneath the Sea* element that was cut out in step 3 of card 1 and adhere it onto the front.



Card #3

1. From the B-side of *Ocean Quest* trim a piece to measure 4½” x 4½” and adhere it to the inside. Trim out the mermaid stamps border strip from *Wild Wild Waves*. Trim again leaving five stamps and adhere to the inside of the card as shown.
2. From *Steampunk Splash* cut a piece to measure 5¼” x 5¼” and adhere it to the front of the card.
3. Ink two more sprockets and layer them together and adhere them along the bottom right as shown.
4. From the B-side of *Aquatic Passage* cut three pieces to measure 2” x ¾”. Flag each piece on one side only creating three banner pieces.
5. From the B-side of *Ocean Quest* cut a piece to measure 3” x 4½”. Adhere the three banner shapes to the right hand side of staggering the middle banner as shown.

6. Add foam adhesive to the back of this element and adhere to the front of the card along the left side. (Note: strategically place the foam adhesive along the right side so the element will lay flat since it overlaps the sprockets.)

7. Trim out the mermaid element from *Wild Wild Waves* and adhere with foam adhesive onto the banner element.

8. From scraps of *Ocean Quest* trim out the sentiment The sea is calling. Add this onto the front with foam adhesive as shown. (Note: you will need a double layer of foam adhesive on the one side to keep the sentiment level). Add the chipboard elements as shown.

9. From the B-side of *Steampunk Splash* trim a piece to measure 8” x ¾” and adhere to the front of the envelope as shown. From *Mermaid Melody* trim out the I am Really a Mermaid element and adhere to the front of the envelope.

You can complete an additional three cards following the same steps using other papers from the collection! Samples Shown to the right.
