— Café Parisian Card Set —

Directions:

Card #1: Petit Fours - Triple Cones & Flowers



1. Cut *Petit Fours* paper (B-side) to 4" x 5¼". Center and adhere to card front. Cut a piece of *Parasol Bouquet* 3½" to 4¾". Pop up and adhere to the center.

2. Cut three 2½" square pieces of leftover *Parasol Bouquet*. Roll each into a cone and glue ends to secure. Cut a decorative pink strip from *Parasol Bouquet* and adhere to the top of each cone. Cut the top of each cone even with the strip, then glue each cone to the lower left corner, diagonally and side-by-side.

3. Choose flowers from the Flower Assortment pack and use generational stamping on the centers and petals of the flowers. Adhere the flowers to the cones making sure to layer the flowers towards the front, back and inside.

4. Using pinking shears or regular scissors, cut strips and tiny pieces of leftover papers to create confetti for both the inside and outside of the cones. Add a small flower chipboard circle and a square flower chipboard circle to the card front. Use a glue gun to fill the cones first, then quickly add pieces of cut papers.

5. Add a strip of *Parasol Bouquet* 1¼" wide to the inside of the card and add your favorite journal card from *Life Is Sweet*.



Card #2: Patisserie - Large Cone

1. Cut a piece of *Postage Patisserie* (B-side) 4" x 5¼" and adhere to the card center. Cut a piece of *Café Parisian* (B-side) 3½" x 4¾" and pop up in the center of *Postage Patisserie*.

2. Cut a piece of *Postage Patisserie* 3" x 3" and shape into a cone, gluing the ends together and flattening slightly. From *Crème de la Crème*, cut a strip of pink polka dots and a strip of patisserie words and add to the top of the cone. Tie a

- Generational Stamping refers to the number of times you stamp without re-inking your applicator or stamp.
- Measurements are width x height unless specified.
- The following instructions are for three cards. Use the remaining supplies provided in your kit to create three additional cards by following the steps using other papers!

piece of string around the cone. Use a dab of glue from a glue gun to secure the string on the back of the cone while wrapping it.

3. Add flowers with generational stamping and leaves to the card front as well as a strip of "the best things are Sweet" from *Petit Fours*. Wrap the top of the cone with a strip from *Crème de la Crème*. Add the cone in the lower left corner card front and add fussy cut sweets pouring out of the cone.

4. Add chipboard pieces "Patisserie" and "Boulangerie" to the card front.

5. Add a strip from *Petit Four* to the inside of the card.



Card #3: Upper Crust - Umbrella with Flowers



1. Cut a piece of *Confectionery* (B-side) 4" x 5¼" and adhere to the card front. On top of that layer a piece of *Upper Crust* (B-side) 3½" x 4¾".

2. From *Café Parisian*, fussy cut around the large umbrella, then with a craft knife, cut a slit between the umbrella top and inside, creating a pocket.

3. Choose flowers that you would like pouring out of the umbrella and use the generational inking on each flower.

4. Add a chipboard tag with string to the upper left corner of the card.

5. For the card inside, add a strip of Sweet words from *Crème de la Crème* and an umbrella journal tag.
